- 4. ATR will NOT close until 2021 but even then, might stay open
- 5. Museum asks if there is a demand for reprint of Portrait of RGJ 1966 to 2007, please canvass members and pass on to museum.
- 6. Facebook page is the RGJ the official page, and can get link to webpage and also to all other official news including updates to reunion
- 7. Associations, there is NOT a Rifles Association there is a Rifleman's Association and closer ties are to be encouraged the meeting congratulated the NE branch on its interaction with 8 Rifles.
- 8. Rifleman's Aid Society caters to ALL Riflemen and has about 1,000 cases per year
- 9. To stay in touch with the Rifles join the "Swift" website and register its free
- 10. There have been 8 suicides in the last eleven weeks, those leaving the Army need Association support (but may not want it) be aware.
- 11. Alan Tamblyn gave a talk about Bugles and all the great work they are doing and promised to improve communication.
