Matters arising from last meeting -Update on:

Remembrance Parade: 2015

The raffle brought in £844 which gave us a profit of £344 (prizes £500) which offset the cost of the function giving the branch a profit on the function of £229.29. Our Auction went well the committee thank you to those who donated items the auction raised £420 which will be added to the charity pot in addition Karl Lee Construction in the form of Karl Cowie (John's boy) handed over £400 to pay for the coach for the 50th birthday Horse Guards Parade event, thank you Karl. Also thanks go to Fred, Norman Micky Dalton and Iris and Linda for their contributions and letters will be sent out by our Media Coordinator Fred Barrett.

What did not go so well was the drinks service, we found that staff had been adding drinks to the bills by mistake we add but something we will look to at future events, there was a complaint that a guest was harassed by a member after he had won the fob watch, it's a free draw and anyone can win it. Reserve seating at the event was for committee members as they had duties to perform so couldn't "keep" their table but in future events anyone who has a party of ten or more can ask for a table to be reserved.
